Program: Our program presented by Becky Goldsmith, “A Practical Approach to Color” was very enjoyable.

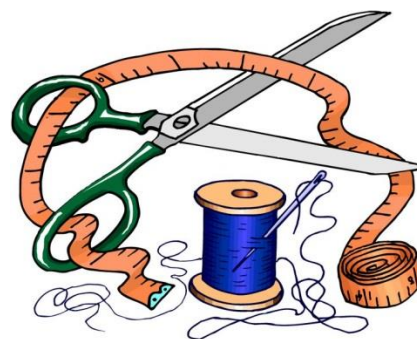
**Announcements:**

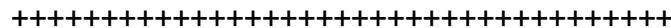
